Post Op Instructions for Custom Made Temporary Crowns

Your temporary crown(s) have been placed with a type of cement that can easily be removed at your next visit.

- ◆ Avoid eating sticky foods – i.e. chewing gum, candy bars, peanut butter sandwiches, etc. as these may adhere to your temporary and lift it off.
- ◆ Avoid eating hard foods – i.e. peanuts, popcorn, hard candies, etc. as these may rock loose or break your temporary.
- ◆ Do not floss in between the temporary crown, gentle brushing only.
- ◆ This custom temporary is made especially for you. It is there to protect your tooth and maintain the integrity and relationship of the adjacent teeth. If for any reason your temporary should come loose or break, please call our office to have it recemented or repaired. This happens very commonly if you are a clencher or a bruxer.
